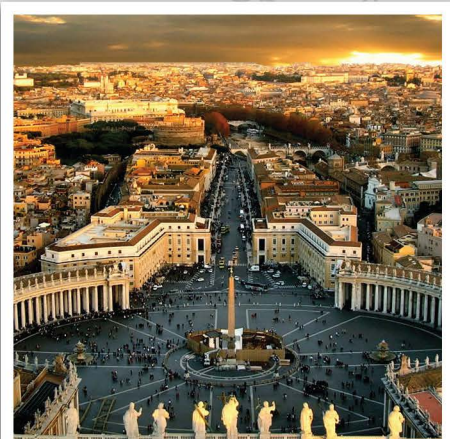
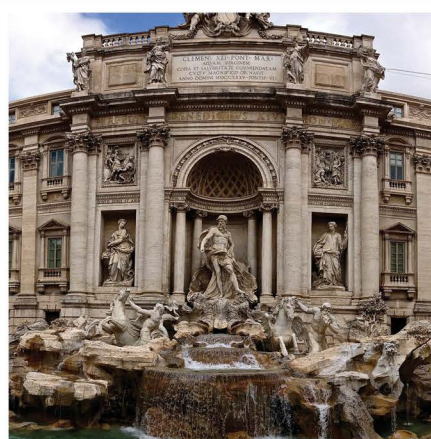

Day by Day Itinerary

NOVEMBER 6: DAY 1: DEPARTURE: Depart en route to the Holy Land with complimentary meals and beverages served aloft.

NOVEMBER 7: DAY 2: ARRIVE TEL AVIV: Upon arrival in Tel Aviv we are greeted by our Holy Land travel Center Representative and continue to our hotel for dinner and overnight. (D)

NOVEMBER 8: DAY 3: HAIFA, CANA, NAZARETH: This morning after breakfast, we begin our pilgrimage by visiting Haifa and the Summit of Mount Carmel, this magnificent garden features 19 terraces and its centerpiece, the gold-domed Shrine of the Bab. Later we head to Mt. Tabor, the site of Christ's Transfiguration, and the beautiful scenery of the Valley of Jezreel. Here we celebrate mass. We visit the small village of Cana, site of Jesus' first miracle at the wedding feast. Here, couples will have the opportunity to renew their wedding vows. Continue to Nazareth for overnight. (B, D)

NOVEMBER 9: DAY 4: TIBERIAS, SEA OF GALILEE: Begin the day with a visit to Capernaum where our Lord Jesus chose to center his ministry. Celebrate mass in the Church of St. Peter. At Tabgha, you will visit the Church of the Multiplication of the Fishes and Loaves, and visit the Chapel of

Primacy of Peter. Then we take a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee. Continue to the Mount of Beatitudes where our Lord preached to the multitudes. We then head to Nazareth where we visit the Basilica of the Annunciation for Mass at the Grotto, then continue to St. Joseph's Workshop, Mary's well. (B, D)

NOVEMBER 10: DAY 5: JERUSALEM: MT. OF OLIVES, GARDEN OF GETHSEMANE: This morning, drive to the top of the Mt. of Olives for a spectacular view of Jerusalem. Visit the Church of Pater Noster, the Chapel of Ascension, and then walk the "Palm Sunday Road" to Dominus Flevit, where Our Lord wept over Jerusalem. Continue to the Garden of Gethsemane and the Church of All Nations for Mass on the Rock of Agony. After lunch, we continue onto the Church of St. Peter in Gallicantu (where Peter denied Christ), the House of Caiphas, the Church of the Dormition of Our Lady, and the Upper Room, commemorating the Last Supper. (B, D)

NOVEMBER 11: DAY 6: JERUSALEM: EXCURSION TO BETHLEHEM, EIN KAREM, CHURCH OF VISITATION: Today we start by celebrating Mass at Shepherds' Field, and then visiting the Church of the Nativity, St. Jerome's Chapel, and St. Catherine's Church. After lunch we head to Ein

Karem where we visit the Church of St. John the Baptist and the Church of the Visitation. The balance of the day is at leisure to browse in the local markets. (B, D)

NOVEMBER 12: DAY 7: JERUSALEM: THE OLD CITY, HOLY SEPULCHER: We begin today entering through Stephen's Gate, with a visit to the Church of St. Anne, marking the place of birth of the Blessed Mother, visiting as well the nearby Pools of Bethesda. We proceed to the Chapel of the Flagellation (where Our Lord was scourged), then carry the cross as we follow the Via Dolorosa (Stations of the Cross). After the Stations, we return to the Ecce Homo Arch and Lithostrotos, where we celebrate Mass. Balance of the day in the Old City, where we will have time to visit the Dome of the Rock & Temple Mount (conditions permitting). (B, D)

NOVEMBER 13: DAY 8: JERICHO, DEAD SEA: We depart early this morning towards Jericho to view the Mt. of Temptations. We then visit the "Dead Sea" for a day swim (bring your swim suit). At night, we all gather for a special dinner and overnight. (B, D)

NOVEMBER 14: DAY 9: TEL AVIV / ROME: Today we board our flight to Rome. Upon arrival in Rome we continue to our hotel for check in. And then we Visit Piazza Navona & the Pantheon (D)

NOVEMBER 15: DAY 10: Vatican / St. Mary Major: This Day we Start the day with a visit to the Papal Audience (if Pope Francis is in Rome), then we will have lunch in one of the most special restaurants in the Vatican, and then we start our tour to the Vatican Museums and also we will visit Sistine Chapel, we will then end the day with a visit to St. Mary Major. After that we will have dinner. (L, D)

NOVEMBER 16: DAY 11: ROME, VATICAN, ST PETERBASILICA: This day we start the day with a mass at St. Peter's, then we will visit the Dome of St. Peter's and St. Peter's Basilica, then we will go to lunch. After Lunch we will go to St. John Lateran and then Scala Sancta – Holy Stairs, also this day we will go to Colosseum, after that will have a break for dinner after this full of excitement day, and before we end the day we will visit Trevi Fountain. (L,D)

NOVEMBER 17: DAY 12: ROME, / EXCURSION TO ASSISI: This day is very special, we will take a private Bus to St. Paul Outside the Walls, and then we will continue with our private Bus to Assisi and we will Visit Santa Maria degli Angeli, then will break for Lunch, after lunch we will visit the Basilica of St. Francis also, we will visit Chiesa Nuova and the Basilica of St. Clare. on this day as well we will visit St. Francis Hermitage, after that we will have some FREE TIME, and then we will end the day at a great restaurant for dinner, after dinner we will take our private bus to Rome to check in our Airport Hotel. (L,D)

NOVEMBER 18: DAY 13: RETURN HOME: Today we board our return flights home, carrying with us memories and keepsakes that will last a lifetime.

Terms and Conditions

By making any payments (cash, credit card or otherwise) towards any tour constitutes your unconditional acceptance of all the terms and conditions stated in this brochure. Holy Land Travel Center shall be referred as HLTC within this document.

DOCUMENTS: US citizens require a valid passport. Other nationalities please inquire with the appropriate embassies.

REGISTRATION AND DEPOSIT: Deposit of \$500 per person is required upon registration along with a signed copy of the registration form. Registrations are processed in the order received by HLTC. A second payment of \$1250 is required on or before 03/01/2019. Final payment is due 10/01/2019. Late payments are subject to \$50 late fee. HLTC reserves the right to cancel reservations that are not paid 30 days prior to departure and to apply applicable cancellation/penalties indicated below. No registrations can be made over the telephone.

INDIVIDUAL CANCELLATION FEES & REFUNDS: Upon cancellation of participation of tour by you, the registrant, for any reason, and only after HLTC receives your signed cancellation, HLTC will then refund your payment for services not received by you, minus applicable cancellation fees per person, according to the following schedule:

In addition to any fees / penalties assessed by airlines, the following charges apply:

- 1) Minimum cancellation fee is \$100 from time of registration up to 120 days prior to the tour's departure date.
- 2) From 119 to 60 days prior to departure day, the cancellation fee is \$200 plus any non-refundable amounts paid to and/or penalties assessed by airlines.
- 3) From 59 days to 8 days prior to departure day, cancellation fee is \$300 plus any non-refundable amounts paid to and/or penalties assessed by airlines, hotels, or other suppliers of travel services (up to the total cost of the tour;
- 4) From 7 days prior to departure day onward, no refund is possible.

PASSENGER TRAVEL PROTECTION PROGRAM (HIGHLY RECOMMENDED): Passenger Travel protection program is administered by Travel Guard. This program is available through HLTC and is strongly recommended. Holy Land Travel center is not responsible for damage, loss, or theft of luggage and/or personal belongings, or for personal injury, accident and / or illness. For protection, it is important that you have adequate insurance to cover these possibilities. If you want to purchase travel insurance, you must issue a SEPARATE check to HLTC for \$175 per person. Travel Insurance becomes effective from the date HLTC receives the separate payment.

MEDICAL CONDITION: We endeavor to provide the highest level of service to all our passengers. Participants who require special assistance must be accompanied by a qualified helper who assumes total responsibility for the participants' well being. The HLTC is not responsible for any medical conditions that occur prior, during or after the tour.

LAND TRANSPORTATION AND TRANSFERS: By private deluxe motor coach.

ACCOMMODATIONS: Tour prices are per person, based on two persons sharing double or twin-bedded rooms with private bathroom with tub or shower. Single rooms subject to availability and an additional cost of \$750.

MEALS: Breakfast and dinner according to specifications in itinerary. All lunches and beverages are extra.

TIPPING: The price of the tour does not include tips and gratuities. Tipping is recommended to the Tour Guide and Motor Coach Driver approximately \$6 and \$4 per person, respectively, per day to each; Hotel tips are approximately \$2 per day per person.

Note: While no changes are anticipated, there may be unforeseen occasions when certain alterations become necessary, either due to changes to the airline schedule or any other reason. All Masses are subject to local church schedules and substitution with alternate Mass sites if churches mentioned are not available. Holy Land Travel Center reserves the right to change the itinerary due to such unforeseen circumstances or emergencies.

AIRLINE TICKETS AND ITINERARY LENGTH: Air transportation to/from your destination will be economy class aboard carriers utilizing **non-refundable, non-amenable tickets** for groups flying together for the entire itinerary. Preliminary international flight schedules are available 60 days prior to departure and may change before they are finalized. Therefore, if you book the domestic flight on your own, you will be responsible for changing your domestic flights and incurring any change fees that would be generated by this adjustment. We are not responsible for changes and delays in airline schedules and do not reimburse passengers for expenses resulting from same. Travelers making their own flight arrangements should not purchase non-refundable, non-changeable tickets. We cannot guarantee the most direct routing to your final destination. If flight schedules change, we reserve the right to lengthen or shorten the itinerary accordingly, and if changes or flight schedules necessitate extra overnights, you will be charged at normal hotel rates. Land Only packages do not include airport-hotel transfers.

BAGGAGE: The passenger is allowed to bring one (1) checked bag, which may have a maximum weight of 50 lbs., and maximum combined dimensions of 62 inches. Also, one (1) "carry-on" with maximum dimensions of 8"x12"x20" is permitted. Luggage is the passenger's responsibility and that of the airlines. PRICES: All prices are based on exchange rates and fares applicable at time of quotation and based on minimum number of 30 paying passengers, and are therefore subject to change if fares change (including fuel surcharges increase), if group does not reach minimum or if exchange rates fluctuate.
