# Day by Day Itinerary

**DAY 1, AUGUST 2<sup>ND</sup>, 2021: DEPARTURE USA:** Depart enroute to Rome with complimentary meals and beverages served aloft.

**DAY 2, AUGUST 3<sup>RD</sup>, 2021: ARRIVE ROME:** Upon arrival in Rome, you will be met by your Holy Land Travel Center representative and transferred to your hotel. The rest of the day is at leisure. Dinner and overnight in your hotel.

# Overnight: Rome (D)

DAY 3, AUGUST 4<sup>TH</sup>, 2021: ROME (PAPAL AUDIENCE AND VATICAN MUSEUM TOUR): After breakfast we will explore the spiritual capital for all Catholics around the world. Today attend a papal audience pending the papal schedule, followed by a visit to the Vatican Museums. We will cover the Tapestry Gallery, the Raphael Rooms and the overwhelming Sistine Chapel with the

restored mural of the Last Judgment. Later, enter the largest church in Christendom, St Peter's Basilica, built on the site of St. Peter's tomb. We will also visit the tomb of Pope John Paul II located at the Vatican. Dinner and overnight.

# DAY 4, AUGUST 5<sup>TH</sup>, 2021: ROME (FULL DAY TOURING OF

**CHRISTIAN ROME):** Following breakfast, we depart for full day of highlighting Christian Rome which includes a visit to the Basilica of St. Mary Major, the most important and the oldest church dedicated to Our Lady, which contains relic from the manger of the infant Jesus. Continue to the Basilica of St. John the Lateran, the Pope's Cathedral church where relics of both Peter and Paul remain under the main altar. See the Holy Staircase which is believed to be from Pilate's palace in Jerusalem and brought to Rome by St. Helen in the 4th century. Time permitting, climb the steps on your knees in memory of Christ's Passion, visit St Paul Outside the Walls, and celebrate Mass. Continue on to the Appian Way, the oldest road from Roman times. Visit the famous Domino Quo Vadis Chapel and the catacombs of St. Callixtus where the early Christians hid to escape persecution. Conclude by visiting the Trevi Fountain. Dinner and overnight.

# Overnight: Rome (B, D)

**DAY 5, AUGUST 6<sup>TH</sup>, 2021: ASSISI:** Today we leave Rome and head to Assisi in the Umbria's Region. Upon arrival, we visit the sites of Assisi, birthplace of St. Francis, including the Basilica of Santa Maria Degli Angeli (Our Lady of the Angels). Inside this Basilica, we explore the Portiuncola, the chapel of the Transitus and the Rose Garden. We continue to the Basilica of St. Clare, the Town Hall Square and the Basilica of St. Francis. We enjoy an afternoon at leisure to explore the lovely town with its quaint streets and alleys.

# Overnight: Assisi (B, D)

**DAY 6, AUGUST 7<sup>TH</sup>, 2021: SIENA/ FLORENCE:** This morning, we depart to visit the medieval town of Siena in Tuscany. We visit the Basilica of San Domenico, where the incorrupt head and finger of St.

Catherine lies, and to explore the center and the Piazza del Campo on our own. We continue to Florence in the heart of the Tuscany region.

Overnight: Florence (B, D)

DAY 7, AUGUST 8<sup>TH</sup>, 2021: FLORENCE: This morning we discover the wonders of Florence, "City of Art." We visit the Academy of Fine Arts to view Renaissance masterpieces, including Michelangelo's "David." We explore the wonderful Basilica di Santa Maria del Fiore (Duomo), the Baptistery, Piazza della Signoria, and Santa Croce, housing Michelangelo's tomb.

# Overnight: Florence (B, D)

DAY 8, AUGUST 9<sup>TH</sup>, 2021: FLORENCE: Following breakfast, we head into the Tuscan countryside to explore the region's rich history and culture. We visit San Gimignano, a very well-preserved medieval town dating back to the 12th century. We have free time to walk the streets and taste the local wine. Later, we continue our journey to Pisa to visit the leaning tower; its pretty Romanesque monuments and Cathedral. We return to Florence for dinner and overnight.

# Overnight: Florence (B, D)

**DAY 9, AUGUST 10<sup>TH</sup>, 2021: PADUA:** This morning we head to Verona. Visit this beautiful medieval city related to the Legend of Romeo and Juliet and continue to Padua, where we will visit the famous Cathedral of St. Anthony, guarded by Donatello's "Gattamelata." Evening is at leisure to rest of explore Padua on our own.

# Overnight: Mestre (Venice) (B, D)

DAY 10, AUGUST 11<sup>TH</sup>, 2021: VENICE: After breakfast, we take our private boat to San Marc's Square and explore Venice, nicknamed "la Serenissima." We begin with a guided walking tour of St. Mark's Square, one of the largest open spaces in Venice. We visit two of its landmark buildings, the Basilica of San Marco and the Bridge of Sighs. We will be able to participate in a glass-blowing demonstration. We enjoy a free afternoon to explore on our own, sightsee, shop or take a gondola ride with music on one of Venice's scenic canals.

# Overnight: Mestre (Venice) (B, D)

**DAY 11, AUGUST 12<sup>TH</sup>, 2021: MILAN:** Today we take in the sights of Milan including the famous opera house La Scala; the 19th century Galleria; and Milan Cathedral whose impossible size took nearly 6 centuries to construct. We end our tour of Milan with a special private viewing of Leonardo Da Vinci's fresco masterpiece, the Last Supper, located in the Church of Santa Marie delle Grazzie.

#### Overnight: Milan (B, D)

**DAY 12, AUGUST 13<sup>TH</sup>, 2021: RETURN HOME:** This morning we transfer to Milan's Airport for our return flight with memories and keepsakes to last a lifetime.

# **Terms and Conditions**

By making any payments (cash, credit card or otherwise) towards any tour constitutes your unconditional acceptance of all the terms and conditions stated in this brochure. Holy Land Travel Center shall be referred to as HLTC within this document.

DOCUMENTS: US citizens require a valid passport. Other nationalities please inquire with the appropriate embassies.

REGISTRATION AND DEPOSIT: A deposit of \$500 per person is required upon registration along with a copy of the registration form on or before no later than April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021. Registrations are processed in the order received by HLTC. A second of \$1500 is Due by May 31<sup>st</sup>, 2021, and final payment due by July 15<sup>th</sup>, 2021. Late payments are subject to \$50 late fee. HLTC reserves the right to cancel reservations that are not paid 30 days prior to departure and to apply applicable cancellation/penalties indicated below. No registrations can be made over the telephone.

INDIVIDUAL CANCELLATION FEES & REFUNDS: Upon cancellation of participation of tour by you, the registrant, for any reason, and only after HLTC receives your signed cancellation, HLTC will then refund your payment for services not received by you, minus applicable cancellation fees per person, according to the following schedule:

Additional cancelation fees:

- 1. No cancelation fees up to 60 days prior to the tour's departure date.
- 2. From 60 to 30 days prior to departure day, the cancellation fee is \$500 + 20% of total price.
- From 29 days to 8 days prior to departure day, cancellation fee is \$500 + 50% of total price.
- 4. From 7 days prior to departure day onward, no refund is possible.

#### PASSENGER TRAVEL PROTECTION PROGRAM (HIGHLY RECOMMENDED): Passenger Travel Protection Program is administered by Travel Guard. Holy Land Travel center is not responsible for damage, loss, or theft of luggage and/or personal belongings, or for personal injury, accident and/or illness. This pilgrimage demands a lot of walking and can be strenuous. For protection, it is important that you have adequate insurance to cover these possibilities. To purchase travel insurance, please send a separate check, \$195/person, for insurance coverage to the Holy Land Travel Center. Travel insurance takes effect from the time a SEPARATE payment is received. All Protection Plan fees are non-refundable.

MEDICAL CONDITION: We endeavor to provide the highest level of service to all our passengers. Participants who require special assistance must be accompanied by a qualified helper who assumes total responsibility for the participants' well-being. This pilgrimage demands a lot of walking and can be strenuous. HLTC is not responsible for any medical conditions that occur prior to, during, or after the tour.

LAND TRANSPORTATION AND TRANSFERS: By private deluxe motor coach.

ACCOMMODATIONS: Tour prices are per person, based on two persons sharing double or twin-bedded rooms with private bathroom with tub or shower. In the event that one does not sign up with a roommate and is not able to be paired with another traveler, there will be a single supplement charge of \$850 to the account. Single rooms subject to availability and an additional cost listed on travel brochure terms and conditions.

MEALS: Meals in accordance with the itinerary. All beverages are extra.

TIPPING: Unless it is specified in the tour brochure, the price of the tour does not include tips and gratuities. Tipping is recommended to the tour guide and motor coach driver approximately \$6 and \$4 per person, respectively, per day to each: Hotel tips are approximately \$2 per day per person. Tips may be precollected before the pilgrimage for your convenience.

AIRLINE TICKETS AND ITINERARY LENGTH: Air transportation to/ from your destination will be economy class aboard carriers utilizing nonrefundable, non-amenable tickets.
