### Day by Day Itinerary

April 16 Day 1: Depart USA: Our Pilgrimage begins today as we depart on our flight to Israel. Meals and drinks served aloft.

April 17 Day 2: Arrive Tel Aviv / Tiberias: Upon arrival in Tel Aviv, we are welcomed by our Representative then transferred to our hotel for dinner and overnight. Overnight: Tiberias (Dinner\*)

April 18 Day 3: Magdala, Tabgha, Capernaum, Ginnosar: After breakfast at the hotel, we will depart for a visit of Magdala, home of Mary of Magdala. Later we will continue to Mount of Beatitudes Father will celebrate Holy Mass at an outdoor altar overlooking the Sea of Galilee. Next, we visit Tabgha, where the multiplication of fish and loaves occurred and the Primacy of Peter where Jesus appeared to his disciples after the Resurrection and appointed Simon Peter to the office of the Primacy with the words "Feed my sheep". It is here, that Father will read from the scriptures near the shore of the Sea of Galilee. After lunch, we will sail across the Sea of Galilee to Capernaum, just imagine spending with Our Lord listening to the very waters that he walked upon. Capernaum is where Jesus began his public ministry. Visit the synagogue which dates to the time of Jesus and the site of Peter's home.... and stand just a short distance from the excavated doorway that Jesus stood in when he cured Peter's mother-in-law. Continue with the visit of Ginnosar where a 2000-year fishermen boat was discovered, probably the same type boat used by the disciples. Overnight: Tiberias (Breakfast, Dinner)

April 19 Day 4: Mount Tabor, Nazareth, Cana: After breakfast at the hotel, we will leave Magdala on our way to Mount Tabor, the site of the Transfiguration of Jesus before Peter, John, and James. Celebrate Mass at the Basilica of the Transfiguration and then continue to the lower Galilee with our visit in Nazareth. where Visit the Basilica of the Annunciation where the Angel Gabriel visited Mary in the solitude of silence. Very close by, we will visit the Church of St. Joseph built over the cave which served as his workshop where he taught the child Jesus his trade. More beautiful sites in Nazareth not to be missed are the Synagogue Church, Mary's well Church and Mount Precipice. Our final stop for the day will be to Cana, where our Lord performed his first miracle – changing water into wine at the wedding feast. Here we will invite couples to renew their wedding vows. Then return to our hotel in Magdala. **Overnight:** Tiberias (Breakfast, Dinner)

April 20 Day 5: Acre, Templars Tunnels: This morning we drive West to Acre for the visit of the Old City Visitors center. Visit of the Templars Tunnels. Continue withe visit of the Arab 'shuk' (open market) Drive to Kibbutz 'Lohamei Haget'ao' for the visit of the museum of the Jewish Resistance. Return to our hotel for overnight.

Overnight: Tiberias (Breakfast, Dinner)

April 21 Day 6: Golan Heights, Caesarea Philippi, Mount Bental, Kursi: After breakfast, we board our motor coach and venture north to Golan Heights. We will visit Biblical Dan and see the Alter and King Jeroboam shrine and be reminded of the Biblical lesson of the Golden calf. Continue to Caesarea Philippi. Here you will see one of the main springs of the Jordan River. Caesarea Philippi, also called "Banias", is the location of the testimony of St. Peter and where Jesus answered him, "You are the Rock and upon this rock I will build my Church." Next, drive through the Golan and get to Mount Bental to view the "Road to Damescus". We will return to our hotel and have time for teaching and meditation by the Sea of Galilee. Following this, continue to Bethsaida here Jesus spoke but found lack of faith with the locals. In contrast, at least three of its native sons - Peter, Andrew, and Philip - responded to his call and gave up everything to follow him. Our last visit today will be the site of Kursi or Biblical Gedera or Gederin, the site of the miracle of demons and swine. Here we will see the 1400 years old Byzantine Church that was built to commemorate the event. Overnight: Tiberias (Breakfast, Dinner)

April 22 Day 7: Haifa, Stella Maris, Caesarea Maritime: This morning we will leave the Galilee and drive to the beautiful town of Haifa located on the summit of Mount Carmel. Visit the Stella Maris, the Carmelite Monastery dedicated to Our Lady of Mount Carmel where we will also celebrate Mass. Here, each pilgrim will have an opportunity to be invested with the brown scapular of Our Lady of Mount Carmel. Later we will travel to nearby Horn of Carmel where we will visit "Muchraka" the site of the burning. This is the place where prophet Elijah had a contest with the 400 false Baal prophets as written in 1 Kgs 18, we will visit the Carmelite Monastery built over the Biblical site. Continue to Caesarea Maritime an ancient Mediterranean Port town built by King Herod the Great, this is where Gentiles first heard the Good News from Peter and were baptized here. We will see the Roman theatre and aqueduct. Continue to our hotel in Jerusalem for dinner and overnight

**Overnight:** Jerusalem (Breakfast, Dinner)

April 23 Day 8: Mount of Olives, Palm Sunday Road, Ein Karem: We begin our day by visiting the Mount of Olives and Dominus Flevis where Jesus wept over Jerusalem and the Chapel of the Ascension. Then we visit the Church of Pater Noster. Later we walk down the Palm Sunday Road and visit the Church in the Garden of Gethsemane where you can kneel and pray at the very stone where Christ wept the night before he died. Then, head to Ein Karem, the 'city of Judah' associated with the life of St. John the Baptist. Here we will visit the Church of John the Baptist (built over the site of his birth) and the Church of the Visitation, where Elizabeth first greeted Mary, the Mother of her Lord, and Our Lady first prayed the Magnificat. Here we will celebrate Mass and then end our day with a visit to the Saxum Visitor Center. **Overnight:** Jerusalem (Breakfast, Dinner)

April 24 Day 9: Church of the Nativity, Shepherd's Field, Mount Zion: After breakfast, we head to Bethlehem where we will have an opportunity to visit the Church of the Nativity and celebrate Mass. Here you can kneel and reverence the very spot where the Christ Child was born. Afterwards, we can walk to the Grotto of the Lady Mary where tradition holds that Mary and Joseph stopped during the flight to Egypt. We will also visit Shepherd's Field where the angels announced the birth of the Christ Child to the shepherds. Head back to Jerusalem to visit Mount Zion visit Mount with the Church of the Dormition of Mary, the Cenacle (Upper Room), the Church of St. Peter in Gallicantu where Peter denied Jesus three times and King David's Tomb. Later we will travel to Bethany where Jesus raised Lazarus from the dead.

Overnight: Jerusalem (Breakfast, Dinner)


April 25 Day 10: Jerusalem, Via Dolorosa, Wailing Wall: We will start out our day and walk the Via Dolorosa (Way of the Cross) then visit the Church of the Holy Sepulcher where Father will celebrate Holy Mass at the altar next to the site of the Crucifixion of Christ. Here, you will have an opportunity to kneel in reverence and place your hand in the very hole where Christ's cross was placed in the ground on Good Friday. You may also want to touch the stone where Christ was anointed before his burial. We will also enter the tomb where Christ was buried... it is from this same spot that he was resurrected that first Easter morn. After lunch, we will visit the Wailing Wall, the only remaining remnant of the Temple in Jesus' time. Later we will visit the Church of St. Anne and the Pool of Bethesda. Continue to Notre dame where we will have a tour of the display of a replica of the Shroud of Turin.

Overnight: Jerusalem (Breakfast, Dinner)

April 26 Day II: Masada, Dead Seaa, Qasr El Yahud, Jericho: This morning we depart for Masada, an ancient fortification, a top of an isolated large rock plateau overlooking the Dead Sea, and a symbol of great national pride. Once we arrive, we will ascend Masada via cable car to the top of the rock plateau more than 1,300 feet high, and experience one of the most amazing panoramic views of the Judean Desert, and the Dead Sea with its bright aquamarine color tones. Next, we will visit the site of Qumran, this is where the Dead Sea scrolls were written 2000 years ago and were later found in 1947! After lunch We will arrive to the shores of the Dead Sea and then enjoy a 'float' in the salty waters... you may even choose to cover your body with the mud from the bottom of the Dead Sea. From here we go to Qasr El Yahud the site where the Children of Israel had crossed the Jordan River on their way to the promised land. Continue to Jericho the first town conquered by Joshua. We will ascend the by cable car to the site of the temptation during Christ's 40 days in the dessert. You can enjoy the panoramic view from the rest stop, or you may choose to walk up to the monastery built in the side of the mountain. From there, we will return to Jericho, visiting the sycamore tree where Christ spoke with Zacchaeus the tax collector, see Elisha's spring. On our way back to Jerusalem we drive by the site of the Inn of the Good Samaritan. Tonight enjoy a farewell dinner together. Overnight: Jerusalem (Breakfast, Dinner)

April 27 Day 12: Knesset, Return to USA: After breakfast, visit of Jerusalem new city. Visit of the model of Jerusalem based on the Second Temple period (the era Jesus lived in the land), followed by a visit to the Shrine of the Book Museum housing the Dead Sea Scrolls. Drive to the Knesset, the Israeli Parliament and view of the Menorah, symbol of Israel State. Return to the hotel. Rest and refresh. Lunch on your own. Check out and drive to Tel Aviv airport where we board our flight to return to the U.S.

The tours are professionally organized to ensure that pilgrims receive the highest quality in travel and lodging. But we pride ourselves most on offering a personalized experience. From the first day you are treated like family, welcomed into the local Christian homes, offered stories of faith by residents, and unfettered access to holy sites.

#### Terms & Conditions

By making any payments (cash, credit card or otherwise) towards any tour constitutes your unconditional acceptance of all the terms and conditions stated in this brochure. Holy Land Travel Center shall be referred to as HLTC within this document.

DOCUMENTS: US citizens require a valid passport. Other nationalities please inquire with the appropriate embassies.

REGISTRATION AND DEPOSIT: Deposit of \$500 per person is required upon registration along with a signed copy of the registration form on or before. Registrations are processed in the order received by HLTC A second payment of \$1249 is required on or before 150 days prior to departure. A third payment of \$1000 is due 90 days prior to departure. Final payment is due 45 days prior to departure. Late payments are subject to \$50 late fee. HLTC reserves the right to cancel reservations whose payments are 30 days late and to apply applicable cancellation/penalties indicated below. No registrations can be made over the telephone.

INDIVIDUAL CANCELLATION FEES & REFUNDS: Upon cancellation of participation of tour by you, the registrant, for any reason, and only after HLTC receives your signed cancellation, HLTC will then refund your payment for services not received by you, minus applicable cancellation fees per person, according to the following schedule:

In addition to any cancellation fees specific to your tour, the following fees apply.

1) Minimum cancellation fee is \$500 from time of registration up to 120 days prior to the tour's departure date.

2) From 119 to 60 days prior to departure day, the cancellation fee is 500 + 20% of total price.

3) From 59 days to 8 days prior to departure day, cancellation fee is \$500 + 50% of total price.

4) From 7 days prior to departure day onward, no refund is possible.

TRAVEL PROTECTION: Travel insurance is recommended to help protect you and your trip investment against the unexpected. For your convenience, we offer travel protection. If you do not wish to purchase now, the plan can be purchased any time before submitting your final payment. Coverage takes affect once payment is received. If you chose to purchase outside of the time sensitive period outlined in the plan, you will not be eligible for time sensitive benefits. All plan premiums are non-refundable. MEDICAL CONDITION: We endeavor to provide the highest level of service to all our passengers. Participants who require special assistance must be accompanied by a qualified helper who assumes total responsibility for the participants' well-being. This pilgrimage demands a lot of walking and can be strenuous. HLTC is not responsible for any medical conditions that occur prior to, during, or after the tour.

LAND TRANSPORTATION AND TRANSFERS: By private deluxe motor coach.

ACCOMMODATIONS: Tour prices are per person, based on two persons sharing double or twin-bedded rooms with private bathroom with tub or shower. In the event that one does not sign up with a roommate and is not able to be paired with another traveler, there will be a single supplement charge to the account. Single rooms subject to availability and an additional cost of \$1100.

MEALS: Meals in accordance with the itinerary. All beverages are extra.

TIPPING: Unless it is specified in the tour brochure, the price of the tour does not include tips and gratuities. Tipping is recommended to the tour guide and motor coach driver approximately \$6 and \$4 per person, respectively, per day to each: Hotel tips are approximately \$2 per day per person. Tips may be pre-collected before the pilgrimage for your convenience.

AIRLINE TICKETS AND ITINERARY LENGTH: Air transportation to/from your destination will be economy class aboard carriers utilizing non-refundable, nonamenable tickets. Preliminary international flight schedules are available 60 days prior to departure and may change before they are finalized. Therefore, if you book the domestic flight on your own, you will be responsible for changing your domestic flights and incurring any change fees that would be generated by this adjustment.
