

Itinerario Dia a Dia

Abril 17 Día 1: EE. UU./ París: Hoy abordaremos nuestros vuelos a París con comidas y bebidas servidas en el aire.

Abril 18 Día 2: Llegada a París: Al llegar a París, nuestro representante de HLTC nos recibirá y nos trasladará a nuestro hotel para cenar y pasar la noche.

Pernoche: París (C)

Abril 19 Día 3: París: esta mañana comenzamos nuestro recorrido con un impresionante ejemplo de arquitectura gótica que tomó dos siglos y ejércitos de trabajadores medievales para completar: la Catedral de Notre Dame. Después de celebrar la Misa en una iglesia local, visitamos la Sainte-Chapelle "Sagrada Capilla", y su vitral, que es considerado el mejor de su tipo en el mundo. Más tarde visitamos los Campos Elíseos y la Torre Eiffel.

Pernoche: París (D, C)

Debido al trágico incendio en la Catedral de Notre Dame el 15 de abril de 2019, los peregrinos no podrán ingresar a la Catedral en el futuro cercano. Los peregrinos aún tendrán la oportunidad de ver la Catedral desde el exterior, y esperamos que las reliquias sagradas se exhiban en una iglesia o museo cercano.

Abril 20 Día 4: París/ Lourdes: Despues del desayuno saldremos hacia Lourdes, lugar de nacimiento de Bernadette. Una vez que llegamos, nos registramos en nuestro hotel. Despues de la cena todos nos unimos a la procesión de las velas.

Abril 21 Día 5: Lourdes: Este día comenzamos con una misa en la Gruta de Massabielle, donde Nuestra Señora se apareció a Bernadette en 1858. Luego tomamos nuestra foto oficial de grupo frente a la Basílica, seguido de nuestra visita guiada a Lourdes: El santuario de la Basílica de San Pío X, la iglesia subterránea más grande del mundo. La Basílica, Los Baños, donde se han llevado a cabo miles de curaciones milagrosas, es el santuario y santuario más respetado de Francia. También se visitarán sitios asociados con la vida de Santa Bernardita, como el Molino de Boly, donde nació; el Locale Mill - residencia de sus padres; el Cachot - antiguamente utilizado como cárcel donde vivía en el momento de las Apariciones; la Capilla - donde recibió su primera Comunión; y la Iglesia Parroquial - que contiene la pila bautismal donde fue bautizada. Por la tarde, nuestro grupo se unirá a la Procesión del Santísimo Sacramento y Bendición de los enfermos (si está disponible ese día).

Abril 22 Día 6: Lourdes: Hoy tendremos un día libre en Lourdes para nuestras actividades personales.

Abril 23 Día 7: Lourdes/ Barcelona: Hoy salimos de Lourdes y conducimos por los Pirineos hasta Andorra la Vella y vemos las iglesias románicas y casas de piedra en el barrio de la ciudad junto con una visita al Santuario de Nuestra Señora de Meritxell. Continuamos hacia Barcelona, la capital de Cataluña y exploramos los coloridos mercados de Las Ramblas antes de trasladarnos a nuestro hotel.

Abril 24 Día 8: Barcelona: Despues del desayuno disfrutaremos de un tour panorámico de Barcelona incluyendo vistas panorámicas de la zona del puerto, Montjuic, Plaza de España y Plaza de Catalunya. Luego visitaremos la Catedral de Barcelona seguida de una visita a La Sagrada Familia de Gaudí, una magnífica basílica católica romana

inacabada de impresionantes proporciones. Continuaremos hacia la colina del Tibidabo donde visitaremos la Iglesia del Sagrado Corazón y veremos una estatua de Cristo cuyos brazos extendidos sobre Barcelona recuerdan a Río de Janeiro.

Pernoche: Barcelona (D, C)

Abril 25 Día 9: Barcelona: Esta mañana viajaremos fuera de Barcelona para visitar el Santuario de Nuestra Señora de Montserrat, el corazón espiritual de Cataluña y hogar de un monasterio benedictino dramáticamente ambientado. Durante 700 años este santuario mariano ha atraído a miles de peregrinos de todo el mundo. Nos detenemos aquí para visitar la Virgen Negra de Montserrat, probablemente la devoción más ferviente de España a la Santísima Virgen. Regreso a Barcelona con el resto de la tarde libre.

Pernoche: Barcelona (D, C)

Abril 26 Día 10: Barcelona/ Zaragoza/ Toledo: Esta mañana salimos de Barcelona y nos dirigimos a Toledo. En nuestro camino pasaremos por Zaragoza donde visitaremos la Basílica de nuestra señora del Pilar. Tiempo para almorzar antes de continuar hacia nuestro hotel en Toledo para cenar y pasar la noche.

Pernoche: Toledo (D, C)

Abril 27 Día 11: Toledo: Despues del desayuno, pasamos el día en Toledo, que se asienta sobre un montículo rocoso aislado por tres lados por un desfiladero serpenteante del río Tajo. Cada centímetro disponible de este afloramiento tiene iglesias, sinagogas, mezquitas y casas amontonadas unas sobre otras en una espiral desordenada, que las calles empedradas se infiltran lo mejor que pueden. Toledo es conocida como la Ciudad de las Tres Religiones o Culturas porque durante muchos siglos cristianos, moros y judíos convivieron en relativa igualdad y paz. La ciudad rodeada de murallas esconde grandes tesoros: su imponente Catedral, la iglesia de Santo Tomé, la Sinagoga del Tránsito, la Sinagoga de Santa María La Blanca, la soberbia iglesia de San Juan de los Reyes, Puerta de Bisagras, Puerta del Cambrón, Puerta del Sol, etc. Continuamos hacia el hotel para cenar y pasar la noche.

Pernoche: Toledo (D, C)

Abril 28 Día 12: Toledo/ Fátima: Hoy partimos hacia Fátima. Llegada a Fátima, donde Nuestra Santísima Madre visitó a tres niños pastores, Lucía Santos y sus primos Bl. Jacinta y Bl. Francisco Marto en 1917, con un mensaje de gran esperanza para el mundo, a tiempo para la Procesión del Rosario y las Velas.

Pernoche: Fátima (D, C)

Abril 29 Día 13: Fátima: Este día está dedicado a las actividades religiosas con nuestro Tour Escort. Despues de la cena asistimos a la procesión de velas.

Abril 30 Día 14: Lisboa: Comenzamos nuestro recorrido hoy viajando a Santarem donde ocurrió el Milagro Eucarístico. Luego nos trasladamos a Lisboa donde admiramos el Monumento a los Descubrimientos y la Torre de Belem desde el exterior. Despues nos dirigimos a Baixa (centro), caminamos desde la Plaza del Comercio a través de la Plaza Rua Augustato Rossio antes de dirigirnos a Alfama.

May 1 Día 15: Regreso EE. UU.: Hoy nos despedimos de Portugal y abordamos nuestros vuelos a casa, llevando con nosotros recuerdos y recuerdos que durarán toda la vida.

Terms & Conditions

By making any payments (cash, credit card or otherwise) towards any tour constitutes your unconditional acceptance of all the terms and conditions stated in this brochure. Holy Land Travel Center shall be referred to as HLTC within this document.

DOCUMENTS: US citizens require a valid passport. Other nationalities please inquire with the appropriate embassies.

REGISTRATION AND DEPOSIT: Deposit of \$500 per person is required upon registration along with a signed copy of the registration form on or before. Registrations are processed in the order received by HLTC. A second payment of \$1249 is required on or before 150 days prior to departure. A third payment of \$1000 is due 90 days prior to departure. Final payment is due 45 days prior to departure. Late payments are subject to \$50 late fee. HLTC reserves the right to cancel reservations whose payments are 30 days late and to apply applicable cancellation/penalties indicated below. No registrations can be made over the telephone.

INDIVIDUAL CANCELLATION FEES & REFUNDS: Upon cancellation of participation of tour by you, the registrant, for any reason, and only after HLTC receives your signed cancellation, HLTC will then refund your payment for services not received by you, minus applicable cancellation fees per person, according to the following schedule:

In addition to any cancellation fees specific to your tour, the following fees apply.

- 1) Minimum cancellation fee is \$500 from time of registration up to 120 days prior to the tour's departure date.
- 2) From 119 to 60 days prior to departure day, the cancellation fee is \$500 + 20% of total price.
- 3) From 59 days to 31 days prior to departure day, cancellation fee is \$500 + 50% of total price.
- 4) From 30 days prior to departure day onward, no refund is possible.

TRAVEL PROTECTION: Travel insurance is recommended to help protect you and your trip investment against the unexpected. For your convenience, we offer travel protection. If you do not wish to purchase now, the plan can be purchased any time before submitting your final payment. Coverage takes effect once payment is received. If you chose to purchase outside of the time sensitive period outlined in the plan, you will not be eligible for time sensitive benefits. All plan premiums are non-refundable. MEDICAL CONDITION: We endeavor to provide the highest level of service to all our passengers. Participants who require special assistance must be accompanied by a qualified helper who assumes total responsibility for the participants' well-being. This pilgrimage demands a lot of walking and can be strenuous. HLTC is not responsible for any medical conditions that occur prior to, during, or after the tour.

LAND TRANSPORTATION AND TRANSFERS: By private deluxe motor coach.

ACCOMMODATIONS: Tour prices are per person, based on two persons sharing double or twin-bedded rooms with private bathroom with tub or shower. In the event that one does not sign up with a roommate and is not able to be paired with another traveler, there will be a single supplement charge to the account. Single rooms subject to availability and an additional cost indicated on the brochure.

MEALS: Meals in accordance with the itinerary. All beverages are extra.

TIPPING: Unless it is specified in the tour brochure, the price of the tour does not include tips and gratuities. Tipping is recommended to the tour guide and motor coach driver approximately \$6 and \$4 per person, respectively, per day to each. Hotel tips are approximately \$2 per day per person. Tips may be pre-collected before the pilgrimage for your convenience.

AIRLINE TICKETS AND ITINERARY LENGTH: Air transportation to/from your destination will be economy class aboard carriers utilizing non-refundable, non-amenable tickets. Preliminary international flight schedules are available 60 days prior to departure and may change before they are finalized. Therefore, if you book

the domestic flight on your own, you will be responsible for changing your domestic flights and incurring any change fees that would be generated by this adjustment. We are not responsible for changes and delays in airline schedules and do not reimburse passengers for expenses resulting from such occurrences. Travelers making their own flight arrangements should not purchase non-refundable, non-changeable tickets. We cannot guarantee the most direct routing to your final destination. If flight schedules change, we reserve the right to lengthen or shorten the itinerary accordingly, and if changes or flight schedules necessitate extra overnights, you will be charged at normal hotel rates. Land Only packages do not include airport-hotel transfers.

SEAT ASSIGNMENT: THERE IS NO ADVANCE SEAT SELECTION FOR TOUR DEPARTURES. HLTC cannot guarantee specific seats, which are at the discretion of the airline and are pending availability. When HLTC disperses travel packages, you will receive your record locator. You can use this locator to do online seating arrangements, if permitted by the airline.

BAGGAGE: Transatlantic and transpacific flights to and from the USA allow the passenger to bring one (1) checked bag, which may have a maximum weight of 50 lbs., and maximum combined dimensions of 62 inches. Also, one (1) "carry-on" with maximum dimensions of 8"x12"x20" is permitted. Luggage on domestic flights will cost extra. Luggage is the passenger's responsibility and that of the airlines. For lost luggage, the passenger is responsible for notifying the airline directly. Check with your carrier regarding carry-on luggage rules and regulations.

PRICES: All prices are based on exchange rates and fares applicable at time of quotation and based on minimum number of paying passengers stated in the brochure and are therefore subject to change if fares change (including fuel surcharges increase), if group does not reach minimum or if exchange rates fluctuate. Minimum number of paying passengers is 20.

NOT INCLUDED: Passport and Visas, meals not mentioned, beverages with meals, extra beyond standard menu, excess baggage, luggage on domestic flights, telephone calls, fuel surcharges increase.
