# Day by Day Itinerary

DAY 1, MARCH 7TH: DEPART USA: Depart for your flights to Tel Aviv. Dinner on-board, relax, and anticipate your arrival the next day.

DAY 2, MARCH 8TH: Tel Aviv: Arrive to The Holy Land: We are greeted upon arrival by our Holy Land Travel Center Representative who will accompany us throughout the pilgrimage. We then transfer to our hotel in Bethlehem to check in for our two-night stay. We will then make the short journey to celebrate Mass at a nearby church before returning to our hotel for a welcome dinner and overnight.

### Overnight: Bethlehem (Breakfast, Dinner)

DAY 3, MARCH 9TH: Bethlehem/ Ein Karem: Visitation of Mary And Birthplace of Jesus: On our first day in the Holy Land, we present an overview for a better understanding of its geography and some of the key sites surrounding the area and what makes it such a unique area to the three major religions – Judaism, Christianity and Islam. We then head to the village of Ein Karem, the birthplace of St John the Baptist and to the Church of Visitation where the Blessed Virgin Mary visited her cousin, Elizabeth, and proclaimed the 'Magnificat'. There, we will enjoy time for prayer and reflection before continuing our journey. In the afternoon we drive to the Shepherd's Fields where the angels announced the birth of Jesus. We then discover the Church of the Nativity in Bethlehem that stands upon the site where Jesus was born. After celebrating a special Mass we will return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

### Overnight: Bethlehem (Breakfast, Dinner)

DAY 4, MARCH 10TH: Caesarea/ Haifa/ Nazareth: After breakfast, we head to Haifa. Upon our arrival, we will visit Stella Maris, a Carmelite Monastery with the Madonna of Mt Carmel. After our tour and an hour of prayer and reflection we will proceed to the Basilica of the Annunciation where we will celebrate Mass. In the afternoon, we will continue East to explore the House of the Holy Family and, time permitting, enjoy a visit to Joseph's carpentry shop. We end the day by checking in to our hotel in Tiberias before sharing a delicious dinner as we look out over the Sea of Galilee.

### Overnight: Nazareth/Tiberias (Breakfast, Dinner)

DAY 5, MARCH IITH: Tiberias: The Ministry of Christ in the Galilee: Today we will take boat ride across the Sea of Galilee to Capernaum to see the synagogue and St Peter's house, a visit to the Mount of the Beatitudes where the Sermon on the Mount was given, to Tabgha to see the splendid mosaic about the miracle of the loaves and fishes, and to the nearby Church of Peter's Primacy where Peter was told "Feed my lambs, feed my sheep." There we will experience an unforgettable Mass near the shores of the Sea of Galilee at the Primacy or Mt Beatitudes. Next, we head the Magdala Center, the village of Mary Magdalene, where we visit the newly built church on site and the newly excavated ruins. Here, we will also enjoy an hour for prayer and reflection to close this amazing day. We then continue to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

#### Overnight: Nazareth/Tiberias (Breakfast, Dinner)

DAY 6, MARCH 12TH: Cana/ Mt Tabor: After breakfast, we drive to Cana, the place where, according to the Fourth Gospel, Jesus performed "the first of his signs", his first public miracle, the turning of a large quantity of water into wine at a wedding feast (John 2, John 2:1–11). We then head to Mount Tabor, the site of the Transfiguration. Here we will celebrate a special Mass together followed by Holy Hour atop the mountain. After descending the mountain, we will proceed on our journey with a stop at the Jordan River to remember our Lord's baptism before continuing to a visit (or rather, a float!) in the Dead Sea. We end the day by checking in to our hotel in the Holy City of Jerusalem where we will enjoy dinner and some deserved rest.

#### Overnight: Jerusalem (Breakfast, Dinner)

DAY 7, MARCH 13TH: Mt Of Olives/ Mt. Zion: We begin our day with a visit to Bethany where Jesus raised Lazarus from the dead. Afterwards, we proceed to the Mount of Olives where Jesus prayed and then to the church of Pater Noster where Jesus taught the disciples the Lord's Prayer. Next, we walk the Palm Sunday road, stopping at Dominus Flevit, where Jesus wept over Jerusalem. Together, we will pray the Lamentations of Jeremiah before continuing to Gethsemane, the Rock of Agony where Jesus prayed His last prayer before his arrest. Next, we head to Mount Zion, visiting the cave of Assumption (Dormition Abbey) of Mary to heaven.



We then visit the room of the Last Supper, and the Church of St. Peter Gallicantu, where Peter denied Jesus three times. After dinner at our hotel, we will have the chance to pray a Holy Hour in the Garden of Gethsemane.

Overnight: Jerusalem (Breakfast, Dinner)

DAY 8, MARCH 14TH: Old City Jerusalem: The Way of The Cross: To avoid the crowds, we start our day early with a view of the Sisters of Zion and Ecce Homo where Pilate proclaimed "Behold the man." Next, we retrace the last steps of Jesus as we walk along the Via Dolorosa (Way of Sorrow), through the markets of the Old City praying the Stations of the Cross at each station shrine, we reflect on the greatness of His sacrifice. Finally, we arrive at the Church of the Holy Sepulchre for Mass followed by an afternoon of free time in the Old City of Jerusalem for individual prayers and exploration. Dinner and overnight at our hotel.

Overnight: Jerusalem (Breakfast, Dinner)

DAY 9, MARCH 15TH: Bethany/ Jericho: The Wilderness: We begin our day with a visit to the Wailing Wall – the most sacred place in the world for Jews. We then take a short walk over the Church of the Assumption to celebrate Mass and afterwards view the Tomb of Mary. Our journey together through Jerusalem culminates in a visit to St Anne Church (the traditional birthplace of the Virgin Mary). The rest of our time in the Holy City is reserved for individual exploration and prayer. This evening, we will enjoy a farewell dinner at a local restaurant before returning to our hotel for a night of rest to prepare for our flights home.

Overnight: Jerusalem (Breakfast, Dinner)

DAY 10, MARCH 16TH: USA: Today we bid farewell to the Holy Land and will return with memories and keepsakes that will last a lifetime.

## Terms & Conditions

By making any payments (cash, credit card or otherwise) towards any tour constitutes your unconditional acceptance of all the terms and conditions stated in this brochure. Holy Land Travel Center shall be referred to as HLTC within this document.

DOCUMENTS: US citizens require a valid passport. Other nationalities please inquire with the appropriate embassies.

REGISTRATION AND DEPOSIT: Deposit of \$500 per person is required upon registration along with a signed copy of the registration form on or before. Registrations are processed in the order received by HLTC A second payment of \$1249 is required on or before 180 days prior to departure. Final payment is due 120 days prior to departure. Late payments are subject to \$50 late fee. HLTC reserves the right to cancel reservations whose payments are 30 days late and to apply applicable cancellation/penalties indicated below. No registrations can be made over the telephone.

INDIVIDUAL CANCELLATION FEES & REFUNDS: Upon cancellation of participation of tour by you, the registrant, for any reason, and only after HLTC receives your signed cancellation, HLTC will then refund your payment for services not received by you, minus applicable cancellation fees per person, according to the following schedule:

In addition to any cancellation fees specific to your tour, the following fees apply.

- 1. Minimum cancellation fee is \$350 from time of registration up to 180 days prior to the tour's departure date.
- 2. From 179 to 120 days prior to departure day, the cancellation fee is \$350 + 20% of total price
- 3. From 119 days to 60 days prior to departure day, cancellation fee is \$350 + 50% of total price.
- 4. From 59 days prior to departure day onward, no refund is possible.

TRAVEL PROTECTION: Travel insurance is recommended to help protect you and your trip investment against the unexpected. For your convenience, we offer travel protection. If you do not wish to purchase now, the plan can be purchased any time before submitting your final payment. LAND TRANSPORTATION AND TRANSFERS: By private deluxe motor coach.

ACCOMMODATIONS: Tour prices are per person, based on two persons sharing double or twin-bedded rooms with private bathroom with tub or shower. If one does not sign up with a roommate and is not able to be paired with another traveler, there will be a single supplement charge to the account. Single rooms subject to availability and an additional cost indicated on brochure.

MEALS: Meals in accordance with the itinerary. All beverages are extra.

TIPPING: Unless it is specified in the tour brochure, the price of the tour does not include tips and gratuities. Tipping is recommended to the tour guide and motor coach driver approximately \$6 and \$4 per person, respectively, per day to each: Hotel tips are approximately \$2 per day per person.
