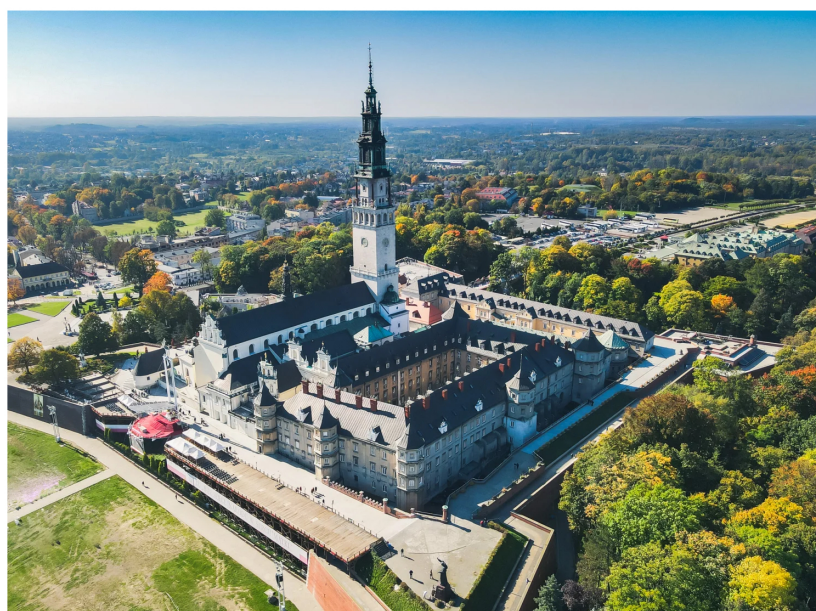

Day by Day Itinerary

28 de abril Día 1: Salida de EE. UU.: Salida a Roma con comidas y bebidas de cortesía servidas en el aire.

29 de abril Día 2: Llegada a Roma: Al llegar a Roma, nos recibirá nuestro representante de Holy Land Travel Center, quien nos acompañará durante todo nuestro recorrido. Comenzaremos de inmediato nuestro recorrido por la Ciudad Eterna. Comenzaremos nuestra peregrinación con una Santa Misa en San Pablo Extramuros, una de las 4 basílicas principales de Roma y nuestra primera Puerta Santa de nuestra Peregrinación Jubilar. Luego nos trasladaremos a nuestro hotel para cenar y pasar la noche.

Pernocte: Roma (Cena)

30 de abril Día 3: Roma: Audiencia Papal y Basílicas Principales: Después del desayuno, el grupo asistirá a uno de los puntos destacados del viaje, la Audiencia Papal. Por la tarde, visitaremos la Basílica de San Juan de Letrán, la basílica más antigua del mundo occidental. Visitaremos la Escalera Santa, que se cree que conducía al pretorio de Poncio Pilato en Jerusalén, y la Basílica de Santa María la Mayor, uno de los santuarios más antiguos e importantes del mundo dedicado a la Santísima Virgen María. Mientras estemos en cada una de estas Basílicas pasaremos por las Puertas Santas ganando una Indulgencia Plenaria para nosotros o para un ser querido que haya fallecido.

Pernocte: Roma (Desayuno, Cena)

1 de mayo Día 4: Roma: Museos Vaticanos y Basílica de San Pedro: Esta mañana visitaremos los Museos Vaticanos y terminaremos en la Capilla Sixtina. Después, visitaremos la Basílica de San Pedro, la basílica católica más grande jamás construida. Aquí pasaremos por la Puerta Santa que, por supuesto, sólo está descubierta y abierta durante los Años Santos. Su imponente cúpula fue diseñada por Miguel Ángel y la famosa escultura de la Piedad del artista y otras innumerables maravillas artísticas hacen de la iglesia de San Pedro uno de los edificios más impresionantes del mundo. Luego, por la tarde, haremos un recorrido a pie para visitar la Fontana de Trevi, el Coliseo y el Panteón.

Pernocte: Roma (Desayuno, Cena)

2 de mayo Día 5: Viena: Esta mañana tomaremos nuestro vuelo a Viena, Austria. Al llegar, nos registraremos en nuestro hotel y tendremos la noche libre.

Pernocte: Viena (desayuno, cena)

3 de mayo Día 6: Viena: Una gran cantidad de tesoros nos esperan en Viena, una de las ciudades más dinámicas de Europa. Nuestro recorrido por Viena incluye visitas al Ayuntamiento, la Ópera Estatal, el Palacio Belvedere, que es la antigua residencia del Príncipe de Saboya, la Catedral de San Esteban, la Iglesia de San Carlos, el Palacio Hofburg y el Kaisergruft. El punto culminante del recorrido es el magnífico Palacio de Schönbrunn con sus 1.400 habitaciones y jardines elaboradamente decorados.

Pernocte: Viena (desayuno, cena)

4 de mayo Día 7: Viena / Praga: Saldremos de Viena esta mañana y realizaremos un recorrido panorámico por el campo hasta Cesky Krumlov y disfrutaremos de un recorrido a pie por esta hermosa ciudad renacentista. Luego continuaremos nuestro viaje hacia Praga.

Pernocte: Praga (desayuno, cena)

5 de mayo Día 8: Praga: Situada sobre el río Moldava, Praga es una de las ciudades mejor conservadas de Europa. La ciudad es famosa por su arquitectura gótica y barroca. Maravillate ante la imponente majestuosidad del Castillo de Praga y la Catedral de San Vito, la Iglesia de Nuestra Señora de la Victoria y la estatua del Niño Jesús de Praga. Después de la misa, cruza el histórico Puente de Carlos, construido en 1400, y admira su estatuaría barroca. Continúa hasta el Santuario de Loreto, uno de los lugares de peregrinación más importantes de Europa del Este. Recuerda las obras maestras atemporales de Mozart, Wagner y Berlioz mientras contemplas los numerosos teatros y casas de ópera de la ciudad.

Pernocte: Praga (desayuno, cena)

6 de mayo Día 9: Cracovia: Esta mañana nos dirigiremos a Cracovia. A la llegada, celebraremos la misa en la Iglesia de San Estanislao, el segundo santuario de peregrinación más importante de Polonia. Visita la catedral de Cracovia, que es la capital espiritual de la nación y en la que se han celebrado la mayoría de las coronaciones y funerales reales del último milenio. Observa el Tesoro de la Catedral y continúa hasta el casco antiguo de Cracovia para ver la calle Kanonicza, donde residió el Papa Juan Pablo II mientras vivió en Cracovia.

Pernocte: Cracovia (desayuno, cena)

7 de mayo Día 10: Cracovia: Esta mañana nos dirigiremos a Wieliczka para ver la mina de sal más antigua de Europa, una atracción turística de clase mundial. Es un lugar único donde muchas generaciones de mineros polacos han creado un mundo de lagos salados subterráneos con un rico interior de capillas decoradas, incluida la famosa Capilla de los Reyes Benditos, además de otras galerías y obras de sal. La mina de sal de Wieliczka está catalogada por la UNESCO como Patrimonio Cultural de la Humanidad. A continuación, nos dirigimos a Wadowice, lugar de nacimiento de Karol Wojtla, el difunto Papa Juan Pablo II. Su museo se encuentra en la casa de su familia. Continuamos hacia un lugar que fue un lugar de peregrinación popular para el Papa cuando era joven: Kalwaria Zebrzydowska, donde en el siglo XVII el Palatino de Cracovia fundó un monasterio franciscano. La iglesia tiene una decoración barroca muy rica. En la ladera de la colina y en el valle hay un "Vía Crucis" arquitectónico que comprende 42 capillas manieristas y barrocas y algunas pequeñas iglesias del Calvario. Español:

Pernocte: Cracovia (Desayuno, Cena)

8 de mayo Día 11: Czestochowa / Santuario de la Divina Misericordia: Después del desayuno, salimos hacia Czestochowa, el lugar del santuario más grande de Polonia, Nuestra Señora de Czestochowa. Celebramos la misa y veneramos el icono invaluable y milagroso. Más tarde visitamos el Convento de las Hermanas de la Misericordia en Lagiewniki, donde vivió y murió Santa Faustina, la Apóstol de la Divina Misericordia. Aquí disfrutaremos de un recorrido por el Convento y celebraremos la misa. Regresamos a nuestro hotel en Cracovia para nuestra cena de despedida y alojamiento.

Pernocte: Cracovia (Desayuno, Cena)

9 de mayo Día 12: Regreso a casa: Hoy abordamos nuestros vuelos de regreso a casa, llevando con nosotros recuerdos y recuerdos que durarán toda la vida.

Terms & Conditions

By making any payments (cash, credit card or otherwise) towards any tour constitutes your unconditional acceptance of all the terms and conditions stated in this brochure. Holy Land Travel Center shall be referred to as HLTC within this document.

DOCUMENTS: US citizens require a valid passport. Other nationalities please inquire with the appropriate embassies.

REGISTRATION AND DEPOSIT: Deposit of \$500 per person is required upon registration along with a signed copy of the registration form. Registrations are processed in the order received by HLTC. Final payment is due 45 days prior to departure. Late payments are subject to a \$50 late fee per week past the due date. HLTC reserves the right to cancel reservations whose payments are 30 days late and to apply applicable cancellation/penalties indicated below. No registrations can be made over the telephone.

INDIVIDUAL CANCELLATION FEES & REFUNDS: Upon cancellation of participation of tour by you, the registrant, for any reason, and only after HLTC receives your written cancellation via email used to register or by US mail., HLTC will then refund your payment for services not received by you, minus applicable cancellation fees per person, according to the following schedule:

- 1) Minimum cancellation fee is \$500 from time of registration up to 120 days prior to the tour's departure date.
- 2) From 119 to 60 days prior to departure day, the cancellation fee is \$500 + 20% of total price.
- 3) From 59 days to 31 days prior to departure day, cancellation fee is \$500 + 50% of total price.
- 4) From 30 days prior to departure day onward, no refund is possible.

PAYMENT: Advertised price is the cash/check discounted price. If paying with a card a processing fee will apply.

BOUNCED CHECKS: Bounced checks will incur a \$25 administrative fee.

DISPUTED PAYMENTS: In the event of a disputed payment for reasons other than a fraudulent charge, the administrative fees associated with a dispute will be invoiced to your account and either deducted from your refund or invoiced to you. These fees are subject to change due to payment processors rules and regulations.

TRAVEL PROTECTION: Travel insurance is recommended to help protect you and your trip investment against the unexpected. For your convenience, we offer travel protection. If you do not wish to purchase now, the plan can be purchased any time before submitting your final payment. Coverage takes effect once payment is received. If you chose to purchase outside of the time sensitive period outlined in the plan, you will not be eligible for time sensitive benefits. All plan premiums are non-refundable. MEDICAL CONDITION: We endeavor to provide the highest level of service to all our passengers. Participants who require special assistance must be accompanied by a qualified helper who assumes total responsibility for the participants' well-being. This pilgrimage demands a lot of walking and can be strenuous. HLTC is not responsible for any medical conditions that occur prior to, during, or after the tour.

LAND TRANSPORTATION AND TRANSFERS: By private deluxe motor coach.

ACCOMMODATIONS: Tour prices are per person, based on two persons sharing double or twin-bedded rooms with a private bathroom with tub or shower. In the event that one does not sign up with a roommate and is not able to be paired with another traveler, there will be a single supplement charge to the account. Single rooms subject to availability and an additional cost indicated on the brochure. Accommodations are subject to change due to upgrade, size of group, etc.

MOBILE APP: Final pilgrimage details will be available through an app before departure. Please be aware that the information on the app is regularly updated and subject to change. HLTC (Holy Land Travel Company) holds no liability for errors or discrepancies in the app's content.

MEALS: Meals in accordance with the itinerary. All beverages are extra.

TIPPING: Unless it is specified in the tour brochure, the price of the tour does not include tips and gratuities. Tipping is recommended to the tour guide and motor coach driver approximately \$6 and \$4 per person, respectively, per day to each: Hotel tips are approximately \$2 per day per person. Tips may be pre-collected before the pilgrimage for your convenience.

AIRLINE TICKETS AND ITINERARY LENGTH: Air transportation to/from your destination will be economy class aboard carriers utilizing non-refundable, non-amenable tickets. Preliminary international flight schedules are available 60 days prior to departure and may change before they are finalized. Therefore, if you book the domestic flight on your own, you will be responsible for changing your domestic flights and incurring any change fees that would be generated by this adjustment. We are not responsible for changes and delays in airline schedules and do not reimburse passengers for expenses resulting from such occurrences. Travelers making their own flight arrangements should not purchase non-refundable, non-changeable tickets. We cannot guarantee the most direct routing to your final destination. If flight schedules change, we reserve the right to lengthen or shorten the itinerary accordingly, and if changes or flight schedules necessitate extra overnights, you will be charged at normal hotel rates. Land Only packages do not include airport-hotel transfers.

SEAT ASSIGNMENT: THERE IS NO ADVANCE SEAT SELECTION FOR TOUR DEPARTURES. HLTC cannot guarantee specific seats, which are at the discretion of the airline and are pending availability. When HLTC disperses travel packages, you will receive your record locator. You can use this locator to do online seating arrangements, if permitted by the airline, any additional costs for seat selection are your responsibility. If your airline ticket is canceled for any reason, you must directly contact the airline to request a refund for your seat selection. The refund will be processed to your original form of payment, subject to the airline's terms and conditions."

BAGGAGE: Transatlantic and transpacific flights to and from the USA allow the passenger to bring one (1) checked bag, which may have a maximum weight of 50 lbs., and maximum combined dimensions of 62 inches. Also, one (1) "carry-on" with maximum dimensions of 8"x12"x20" is permitted. Luggage on domestic flights including Mexico & Canada will cost extra. Luggage is the passenger's responsibility and that of the airlines. For lost luggage, the passenger is responsible for notifying the airline directly. Check with your carrier regarding carry-on luggage rules and regulations.

PRICES: All prices are based on exchange rates and fares applicable at time of quotation and based on minimum number of paying passengers stated in the brochure and are therefore subject to change if fares change (including fuel surcharges increase), if group does not reach minimum or if exchange rates fluctuate. Minimum number of paying passengers is 30.

NOT INCLUDED: Passport and Visas, exit taxes, meals not mentioned, beverages with meals, extra beyond standard menu, excess baggage, luggage on domestic flights, telephone calls, fuel surcharges increase.

VISAS: When and if a visa or visa waiver is required, it is the passenger's responsibility to obtain one. HLTC, owner, agent, or employees cannot be held liable for clients not having proper passports, visa, visa waiver, or other travel documents. Cancellations or changes to schedule due to a lack of appropriate documents will incur usual penalties.

PASSPORTS: Passports are required to travel with Holy Land Travel Center. A Passport Card is not useful for International Air Travel. Attempting to use this instead of a Passport Book will result in a denial of boarding by the airlines and entry by the legal authorities.

PHOTO RELEASE: Photos taken on the pilgrimage may be used to advertise for future pilgrimages by registering for the tour you consent to photographs taken of during your participation in the tour, and to publication of the photographs by the Operator for advertising, promotional and marketing purposes. VISA FOR EUROPE - ETIAS

-Starting in 2025, Americans, Canadians, Australians will need to apply online for travel authorization for Europe.

- This applies to all travelers, and all ages.

- Fee approx. \$9. Per Person

- The program is called ETIAS. Some refer to it as a "visa for Europe". It is not a traditional visa but needs basic details about the traveler and their trip.
