# Day by Day Itinerary

**Day 1: Departure from the USA:** Depart from the United States on your overnight flight to Lisbon, Portugal. Enjoy meals and rest onboard as you begin this spiritual journey.

**Day 2: Arrival in Lisbon – Fátima:** Upon arrival in Lisbon, we are greeted by our tour escort and driver before departing for the holy town of Fátima, one of the world's most beloved Marian pilgrimage destinations.

**Overnight:** Fátima (Dinner\*)

**Day 3: Fátima:** After breakfast, we begin our day with Holy Mass at the Sanctuary of Our Lady of Fátima, one of the world's most important Marian pilgrimage sites, where Our Blessed Mother appeared to Lucia, Francisco, and Jacinta in 1917 with her message of prayer, repentance, and peace. Following Mass, we visit the Basilica of Our Lady of the Rosary, home to the tombs of Saints Francisco and Jacinta Marto and Sister Lucia, as well as the modern Basilica of the Holy Trinity. We then travel to Aljustrel, the village of the shepherd children, and continue to Valinhos, site of one of Our Lady's appearances, with time to walk part of the Stations of the Cross pathway. Throughout the day, pilgrims will have time for private prayer, candle lighting, shopping, and personal devotion at the sanctuary.

**Overnight:** Fátima (Breakfast, Dinner)

**Day 4: Santarem - Nazare – Batalha:** This morning we board our motor coach and make our way south to Santarem, where we visit the site of the Miracle of the Eucharist of Santarem. Here we celebrate Mass. We continue to Nazare, a striking seaside village. Here, we visit the Chapel of Our Lady of Nazare on a cliff overlooking the ocean, devoted to a statue of Our Lady which tradition says was carved originally in Nazareth (Nazare). After some time in Nazare, we will travel to the medieval town of Batalha including its mighty church and the Abbey of Alcobaca. Founded in 1152, the church and monastery are the earliest examples of Gothic architecture in Portugal.

**Overnight:** Fátima (Breakfast, Dinner)

**Day 5: Fátima – Porto – Santiago de Compostela:** After breakfast, we depart Fátima and journey north toward the beautiful city of Porto, one of Portugal's most historic and charming cities. Upon arrival, we enjoy a brief visit of Porto, famous for its colorful riverside architecture, rich Catholic heritage, and world-renowned port wine. We will see highlights such as the historic Ribeira District, the majestic Porto Cathedral, and the scenic Douro River waterfront. During our visit, we will enjoy a guided tour of one of Porto's famous wine cellars, where we will learn about the centuries-old tradition of Port wine production and enjoy a tasting experience. We then continue our pilgrimage journey into Spain toward the sacred city of Santiago de Compostela, one of the most important Catholic pilgrimage destinations in the world and the Final destination of the famous Camino de Santiago. Upon arrival, we check in to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

**Overnight:** Santiago de Compostela (Breakfast, Dinner)

**Day 6: Santiago de Compostela:** After breakfast, we begin our day in the sacred city of Santiago de Compostela, one of Christianity's most important pilgrimage destinations and the final stop of the famous Camino de Santiago. We celebrate Holy Mass at the Cathedral of St. James, built over the tomb of St. James the Apostle, whose remains are venerated by pilgrims from around the world. Following Mass, we visit the tomb of St. James and explore the magnificent cathedral, known for its Romanesque, Gothic, and Baroque architecture. Time permitting, pilgrims may witness the famous Botafumeiro incense burner used during special liturgies. We then enjoy a walking tour of Santiago's charming Old Town, a UNESCO World Heritage Site filled with historic plazas, monasteries, and traditional Galician culture. There will also be free time for prayer, shopping, cafés, or personal exploration.

**Overnight:** Santiago de Compostela (Breakfast, Dinner)

**Day 7: Santiago de Compostela / Oviedo / Santander:** We depart through the beautiful region of Galicia and travel to Oviedo. We visit the Cathedral of Oviedo, whose Chapel of San Miguel houses some important relics from the Middle-Ages, which made it a vital stopping point on the Way to Santiago. The cathedral was also called Sancta Ovetensis. The Holy Chamber is the only surviving portion of the ancient high-medieval complex. It was built to keep such relics and treasures associated with the Asturian Monarchy, such as the Cross of the Angels, Victory Cross and the Agate Casket. The chief feature of the cathedral is the "Camara Santa", (Holy Chamber) with its venerable relics. Bishop Pelagius relates that the Agate Box, a coffer made by the disciples of the Apostles, contains the most precious relics of the Holy City. The coffer was taken from Jerusalem to Africa, and after residing in several locations was finally placed at Oviedo by Alfonso II. After our Mass and visit, we continue to our hotel in Santander for dinner and the evening.

**Overnight:** Santander (Breakfast, Dinner)

**Day 8: Santander / San Sebastian / Lourdes:** After breakfast, we travel to beautiful seaside city of San Sebastian, dramatically set on the Gulf of Vizcaya. The city boasts a lively pedestrian zone. We have some free time at leisure for lunch on our own. We continue on to Lourdes. In 1858, 14-year-old Bernadette Soubirous declared that the Virgin had appeared to her several times in the Cave of Massabielle and had said to her in the local patois, "I am the Immaculate Conception." Today, more than four million pilgrims come to Lourdes each year to bathe in the waters of the miraculous spring. Dinner is served at our hotel. We may wish to participate in the Evening Torchlight Procession.

**Overnight:** Lourdes (Breakfast, Dinner)

**Day 9: Lourdes: Visit of the shrine:** This morning, we celebrate Mass at the Basilica. After Mass, we tour the Sanctuary, Grotto, and Upper Basilica. The afternoon is on our own for lunch and private devotions. At 4:30 pm, we are welcome to participate in the Procession of the Blessed Sacrament and the Blessing of the Sick (subject to a local scheduling). Dinner is served at our hotel, and we might return to the Sanctuary for the Rosary and Torchlight Procession.

**Overnight:** Lourdes (Breakfast, Dinner)

**Day 10: Lourdes: Footsteps of Bernadette walking tour:** We begin this morning early with a concelebrated English Mass at the Grotto. We return to our hotel for breakfast. After breakfast, we take a walking tour "In the Footsteps of Bernadette," visiting the Boly Mill, to see the room where Bernadette was born and the Cachot (the former jail cell where her impoverished family lived at the time of the apparitions). The balance of the day is at leisure for private prayers and devotions. We are welcome to participate in the afternoon and evening procession.

**Overnight:** Lourdes (Breakfast, Dinner)

**Day 11: Lourdes / Toulouse:** After breakfast, we check out of our hotel and travel to Toulouse the city known as La Ville Rose ('The Pink City'). We begin with a view of the Eglise des Jacobins, the brick-built Gothic Church of the Jacobins (1260- 1292) that contains the relics of St. Thomas Aquinas. We will celebrate the closing Mass of our pilgrimage at the Basilica of St. Sernin. After Mass, and some time at leisure for lunch on our own, we visit the city including the Vieux Quartier (Old Quarter).

**Overnight:** Toulouse (Breakfast, Dinner)

**Day 12: Return to the USA:** This morning, after breakfast and checkout, we transfer to the Toulouse airport for our return flight to the USA.

# Terms & Conditions

By making any payments (cash, credit card or otherwise) towards any tour constitutes your unconditional acceptance of all the terms and conditions stated in this brochure. Holy Land Travel Center shall be referred to as HLTC within this document.

**DOCUMENTS:** US citizens require a valid passport. Other nationalities please inquire with the appropriate embassies.

**REGISTRATION AND DEPOSIT:** Deposit of \$500 per person is required upon registration along with a signed copy of the registration form. Registrations are processed in the order received by HLTC. Final payment is due 45 days prior to departure. Late payments are subject to a \$50 late fee per week past the due date. HLTC reserves the right to cancel reservations whose payments are 30 days late and to apply applicable cancellation/penalties indicated below. No registrations can be made over the telephone.

**INDIVIDUAL CANCELLATION FEES & REFUNDS:** Upon cancellation of participation of tour by you, the registrant, for any reason, and only after HLTC receives your written cancellation via email used to register or by US mail., HLTC will then refund your payment for services not received by you, minus applicable cancellation fees per person, according to the following schedule: All refunds will be processed via check. Credit card fees are collected by the payment processor and will not be refunded.

- 1) Minimum cancellation fee is \$500 from time of registration up to 120 days prior to the tour's departure date.
- 2) From 119 to 60 days prior to departure day, the cancellation fee is \$500 + 20% of total price.
- 3) From 59 days to 31 days prior to departure day, cancellation fee is \$500 + 50% of total price.
- 4) From 30 days prior to departure day onward, no refund is possible.

**PAYMENT:** Advertised price is the cash/check discounted price. If paying with a card a processing fee will apply. Card processing fee is nonrefundable.

**BOUNCED CHECKS:** Bounced checks will incur a \$25 administrative fee.

**VOUCHERS:** Travel vouchers issued by HLTC may be applied to a new trip after the initial deposit has been made. To ensure proper processing, all vouchers must be applied no later than 150 days prior to the new trip's departure date. Vouchers cannot be used to cover the initial deposit, nor can they be applied retroactively to previously booked trips. Failure to apply a voucher within the specified timeframe will result in forfeiture of its use for that particular trip. All voucher applications are subject to verification and approval by HLTC.

**DISPUTED PAYMENTS:** In the event of a disputed payment for reasons other than a fraudulent charge, the administrative fees associated with a dispute will be invoiced to your account and either deducted from your refund or invoiced to you. These fees are subject to change due to payment processors rules and regulations.

**TRAVEL PROTECTION:** Travel insurance is recommended to help protect you and your trip investment against the unexpected. For your convenience, we offer travel protection. If you do not wish to purchase now, the plan can be purchased any time before submitting your final payment. Coverage takes effect once payment is received. If you chose to purchase outside of the time sensitive period outlined in the plan, you will not be eligible for time sensitive benefits. All plan premiums are non-refundable. **MEDICAL CONDITION:** We endeavor to provide the highest level of service to all our passengers. Participants who require special assistance must be accompanied by a qualified helper who assumes total responsibility for the participants' well-being. This pilgrimage demands a lot of walking and can be strenuous. HLTC is not responsible for any medical conditions that occur prior to, during, or after the tour.

**LAND TRANSPORTATION AND TRANSFERS:** By private deluxe motor coach.

**ACCOMMODATIONS:** Tour prices are per person, based on two persons sharing double or twin-bedded rooms with a private bathroom with tub or shower. In the event that one does not sign up with a roommate and is not able to be paired with another traveler, there will be a single supplement charge to the account. Single rooms subject to availability and an additional cost indicated on the brochure. Accommodations are subject to change due to upgrade, size of group, etc.

**MOBILE APP:** Final pilgrimage details will be available through an app before departure. Please be aware that the information on the app is regularly updated and subject to change. HLTC (Holy Land Travel Company) holds no liability for errors or discrepancies in the app's content.

**MEALS:** Meals in accordance with the itinerary. All beverages are extra.

**TIPPING:** A total of \$120 per person is collected to cover all standard requirements during the tour. This amount insures fair compensation for the services provided by your tour escort, local guides, and professional driver. It also includes gratuities for hotel staff, specifically for room service during breakfast and dinner. Tips will be pre-collected before the pilgrimage for your convenience.

**AIRLINE TICKETS AND ITINERARY LENGTH:** Air transportation to/from your destination will be economy class aboard carriers utilizing non-refundable, non-amenable tickets. Preliminary international flight schedules are available 60 days prior to departure and may change before they are finalized. Therefore, if you book the domestic flight on your own, you will be responsible for changing your domestic flights and incurring any change fees that would be generated by this adjustment. We are not responsible for changes and delays in airline schedules and do not reimburse passengers for expenses resulting from such occurrences. Travelers making their own flight arrangements should not purchase non-refundable, non-changeable tickets. We cannot guarantee the most direct routing to your final destination. If flight schedules change, we reserve the right to lengthen or shorten the itinerary accordingly, and if changes or flight schedules necessitate extra overnights, you will be charged at normal hotel rate

**SEAT ASSIGNMENT:** THERE IS NO ADVANCE SEAT SELECTION FOR TOUR DEPARTURES. HLTC cannot guarantee specific seats, which are at the discretion of the airline and are pending availability. When HLTC disperses travel packages, you will receive your record locator. You can use this locator to do online seating arrangements, if permitted by the airline, any additional costs for seat selection are your responsibility. If your airline ticket is canceled for any reason, you must directly contact the airline to request a refund for your seat selection. The refund will be processed to your original form of payment, subject to the airline's terms and conditions."

**BAGGAGE:** Transatlantic and transpacific flights to and from the USA allow the passenger to bring one (1) checked bag, which may have a maximum weight of 50 lbs., and maximum combined dimensions of 62 inches. Also, one (1) "carry-on" with maximum dimensions of 8"x12"x20" is permitted. Luggage on domestic flights including Mexico & Canada will cost extra. Luggage is the passenger's responsibility and that of the airlines. For lost luggage, the passenger is responsible for notifying the airline directly. Check with your carrier regarding carry-on luggage rules and regulations.

**PRICES:** All prices are based on exchange rates and fares applicable at time of quotation and based on minimum number of paying passengers stated in the brochure and are therefore subject to change if fares change (including fuel surcharges increase), if group does not reach minimum or if exchange rates fluctuate. Minimum number of paying passengers is 30.

**NOT INCLUDED:** Passport and Visas, exit taxes, meals not mentioned, beverages with meals, extra beyond standard menu, excess baggage, luggage on domestic flights, telephone calls, fuel surcharges increase.

This applies to all travelers, regardless of age, and includes layovers in the UK. These are not traditional visas but require basic personal and trip information.

-ETIAS: Approx. \$9 USD per person for travel to Europe

-UK ETA: Approx. €16 per person, required even for transit through the UK
